Currently, Argosy University is divided into four colleges: College of Business; College of Education; College of Psychology and Behavioral Sciences; and the College of Health Sciences. Argosy University instructors bring more than just a textbook and a syllabus to the classroom. They bring valuable real-world experience. The American School of Professional Psychology, home to the University's numerous psychology programs, resides within the College of Psychology and Behavioral Sciences with the majority of courses taught by doctoral-level, practicing counselors and psychologists. Faculty members in the College of Business are practicing professionals and business leaders. The College of Education faculty members are experienced educators dedicated to helping their students further develop their skills and reach their goals. And in the College of Health Sciences, licensed practitioners work in the fields they teach. Program availability and credential level varies by campus.

Through Argosy University's College of Business, students have the opportunity to acquire the tools needed to compete and succeed in the complex business environment of today and tomorrow. They will have the opportunity to learn not just how to manage companies, but how to lead people by integrating business principles with psychology and behavioral sciences. **Campus Description**

Argosy University, Salt Lake City was founded in 2008 and occupies approximately 38,000 square feet of classroom, computer lab, library, and office space.

Argosy University was formed in September 2001 by the merging of three separate academic institutions. The American School of Professional Psychology was founded in the early 1970s by a group of psychologists, educators, and other professionals who called for a clinical psychology degree that emphasized teaching and practical training over the research-oriented approach of the traditional PhD degree. The University of Sarasota had for more than 30 years offered degree programs in business and education to working adults through a delivery format that mixed distance learning and brief, intensive on-campus study periods. Responding to the emerging needs of the medical community, the Medical Institute of Minnesota was established in 1961 to prepare skilled allied healthcare personnel for careers in the booming medical technology fields.

Building on these successful foundations, Argosy University today comprises five colleges within 19 campus locations across the U.S., and also offers degree programs online.

### **From Provo and Points South**

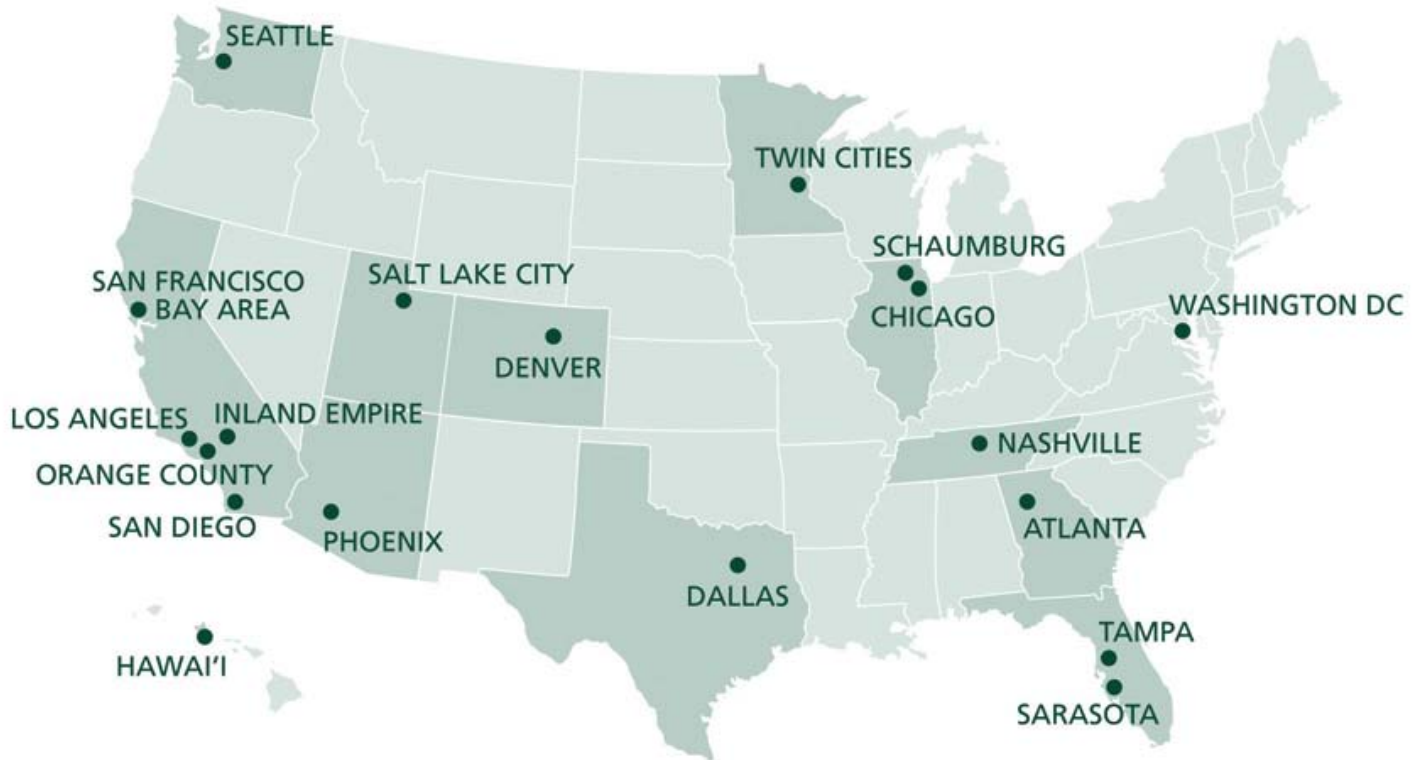
