Argosy University is pleased to offer several scholarship awards. These awards have been developed to recognize and provide financial assistance to eligible students pursuing their education at an Argosy University campus.

Scholarship awards range from \$1,000 to \$5,000 for the academic year. Applying for an Argosy University Scholarship is easy. Applications are accepted until the beginning of a term, however, since funds are limited, you are encouraged to apply early.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Students must have applied for admission at an Argosy University campus.
- Students must be degree seeking.
- Students must be enrolled at least half-time although preference may be given to full-time students.
- Scholarships may be applied to tuition only.
- Students must have completed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine financial need. (International students are exempt from this requirement.)
- Scholarship applications can only be submitted for one award to a single Argosy University campus. (Applications to multiple campuses will be rejected.)
- Scholarships are made for one, two, or three semesters at the discretion of the campus.
- Students who defer their admission to another semester will need to reapply for the scholarship.

Students may apply for only one scholarship. Award amounts range from \$1,000 to \$5,000 for the academic year. Pay close attention to the requirements for each award.

New Students Only:

- ❑ **ACADEMIC AWARD** For students who have demonstrated outstanding academic performance in high school and/or college. Graduate GPA requirement 3.7; undergraduate GPA requirement 3.3. (Minimum number of completed college coursework is 12 credit hours). May be renewable for one year based on maintaining the above GPA requirement.
- ❑ **ALUMNI AWARD** For Argosy University alumni who have previously completed a program and are returning to Argosy University to pursue an advanced degree. Graduate GPA requirement 3.7; undergraduate GPA requirement 3.5. May be renewable for one year based on maintaining the above GPA requirement.
- ❑ **COMMUNITY COLLEGE AWARD** For students who have completed an associate's degree within the last year and are pursuing a bachelor's degree. GPA requirement 3.0. May be renewable for one year based on maintaining the above GPA requirement.
- ❑ **COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD** For students who have demonstrated outstanding community service involvement. Priority is given to applicants working with underserved populations. Please submit a letter of recommendation from the agency describing your service and merit of this award. May be renewable for one year provided community service involvement is maintained.
- ❑ **DIVERSITY AWARD** For students of all backgrounds who have demonstrated significant personal growth or community involvement related to their heritage. Please submit a 500-word typed essay describing your experience. In addition, please submit documentation of awards or letters of recognition you may have received. May be renewable for one year.
- ❑ **LEADERSHIP AWARD** For students who have demonstrated leadership abilities through community involvement, student government, military service, or present employment, etc. Please submit a 500-word typed essay describing your experience as a leader. In addition, please submit letters of recognition or other documentation demonstrating your contribution as a leader. May be renewable for one year.
- ❑ **RETURNING ADULT AWARD** For adult learners, age 25 and older, who are returning to school to pursue a degree and have been out of school for at least two years. Please submit a 500-word typed essay expressing your knowledge gained through life-experiences related to interests, career paths, family commitments, and/or other responsibilities which have influenced your current educational goals and objectives. May be renewable for one year provided the student has been making satisfactory academic progress toward a degree.

Currently Enrolled Argosy Students Only:

- ❑ **ARGOSY UNIVERSITY MERIT AWARD** For currently enrolled Argosy University students who have demonstrated financial need (as defined by the Expected Family Contribution from the FAFSA) and outstanding academic performance. Graduate GPA requirement 3.5; undergraduate GPA requirement 3.3. Students may only apply once a year. May be renewable for one year based on maintaining the above GPA requirement.
